## **Mission Statement:**

**To award youth their participation in the statewide exhibition of livestock projects while helping to promote a fun and honest atmosphere at participating livestock events. To encourage the youth to more eagerly participate in livestock events and to provide educational and skill-building opportunities to enhance the knowledge of youth about the livestock industry.**

## **Snake River Show Circuit Rules and Guidelines:**

### **I. Organization**

- a. The SRSC is a summer livestock circuit that consists of sanctioned shows and youth activities.
- b. The at large representatives will serve as the official record keepers.
- c. The show season for the SRSC livestock Circuit is May-Sept
- d. No rules will be added or excluded between May 15- Sept 1
- e. The annual meeting will be held in the fall following the completion of the show season.

### **II. Eligibility and Membership**

- a. Membership is open to youth ages 19 and under as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.
- b. Annual membership fee will be assessed to become a member of the SRSC.
- c. Members must be signed up and paid before the beginning of the most current show. Points will NOT be accumulated until dues are paid and member is in good standing with the SRSC.
- d. The SRSC is not responsible for the management of the sanctioned shows. All sanctioned events are run independently of the SRSC. All exhibitors are expected to honor the rules of the show in which they are participating.
- e. SNAKE RIVER SHOW CIRCUIT is NOT responsible for any accidents.

### **III. Sanctioned Shows**

- a. All SRSC Sanctioned Shows are encouraged to have the following aspects to their show:
  - i. Quality

1. Hogs
    - Encouraged to keep as close to 8 animals per class and no more than 10.
    - Divisions should be not less than 32 head.
  2. Sheep-2 divisions
    - Divisions: Prospect up to 109 pounds, Market 110 pounds and up
  3. Goats-2 divisions
    - Divisions: Prospect up to 64 pounds, Market 65 pounds and up
  4. Beef-2 divisions
    - Market Steers, Market Heifers
- ii. Showmanship Divisions
1. Pee-Wees 2-7
  2. Juniors 8-11
  3. Intermediate 12-14
  4. Senior 15-19

- b. Total year end points accumulated will be based on the 50% + 1 rule. Example: if there are 7 sanctioned shows for hogs 50% + 1 will equal 4 that each member could collect points at. Their highest 4 scores will be counted.
- c. All shows must submit a finalized list of class placing and champions within three business days of the conclusion of the show. The official email address is: [snakerivershowcircuit@gmail.com](mailto:snakerivershowcircuit@gmail.com)
- d. All animals purchased from benefactors must have a copy of their bill of sale with the registration form.
- e. Market hogs shall not exceed 300 lbs at any show during the show season. No max for sheep, goats and beef.
- f. Livestock must be entered in the name of the SRSC member to accumulate points from the exhibition of the animal.
- g. In showmanship classes, the exhibitors must show their own animal.
- h. The SRSC will not be responsible for the formation or enforcement of the individual show rules. These are the sole responsibility of the show management.
- i. The SRSC requires that each show must allow an official SRSC booth at each sanctioned show.

#### **IV. Prizes and Awards:**

- a. PRIZES ARE SOLELY DEPENDENT ON FUNDING
- b. Prizes will be awarded for top finishers in each of the following categories:
  - I. Quality
  - II. Showmanship
  - III. Livestock Quiz knowledge

- c. If there is a tie the Livestock Quiz Knowledge offered at each show will be the tie breaker.
- d. In the event that there is a Livestock Quiz Knowledge tie, quiz questions will be asked at the end of the year banquet to break that tie to determine the winner of the Quiz Knowledge.
- e. Livestock Quiz Knowledge will consist of combined species (swine, sheep, goats and beef)

**v. Points System:**

- a. Points will be awarded for the Quality classes as follows:

- b. Showmanship points will be awarded for top places as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> 10 points

2<sup>nd</sup> 9 points

3<sup>rd</sup> 8 points

4<sup>th</sup> 7 points

5<sup>th</sup> 6 points

6<sup>th</sup> and below 5 points

- c. To appeal or report a problem with the point system it must be reported within 10 days of the show in question to the official SRSC email address.
