Rules:

1. All ewes and does must have a Scrapies tag. Heifers must have a Bangs tag. Lambs must show milk teeth. Female animals are eligible for breeding and market classes.
2. Animals with clinical or visible signs of prolapse, infectious, contagious, or toxicological diseases will not be permitted to show and will be asked to leave immediately. Out of state animals must have health papers and have individual ID on health certificate.
3. Pens are available. Pens must be clean before departure or exhibitor will pay any fines. Bedding is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
4. Only youth exhibitors that have a signed liability waiver are allowed to show or assist another youth in the show ring.
5. Premiums will be paid on a percentage basis, based on sponsors, number of animal entries, overall class placing, and only after show expenses are paid. Checks will be mailed within 10 days of completion of show.
6. All exhibitors will respect and honor the International Show Ring Code of Ethics.

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7. Exhibitors are subject to disqualification and/or forfeit for any violations.
8. Any and all questions, problems or situations arising at any time before, during, or after the show covered by the rules printed herein, shall be decided upon at the discretion of show management. Show management reserves the right to make changes to improve the show. Such decisions shall be final and not subject to appeal.
