

2020 STATELINE SHOWCASE AND LES BOIS SPRING CLASSIC VIRTUAL SHOW RULES & INFORMATION

1. The Stateline Showcase will be under the direction of Melissa & Jason Sherman (hogs), Matt & Rebekah Wagster (sheep & goats), and Nikki VanLith (beef).
2. Les Bois Spring Classic will be under the direction of Kirk Pugsley and Family
3. Exhibitors will pay 1 entry fee of \$60 per entry and will compete in both shows automatically. They will be sorted by 2 separate judges.
4. This show is open to residents of the following states: Idaho, Oregon, Washington, Montana, Wyoming, Utah, and Nevada.
5. All exhibitors must be 2-19 years of age as of January 1, 2020.
6. Entry and video submissions open May 26th at 8 am PST and will close May 27th at 7 pm PST. (WATCH FOR THE LINK VIA BOTH SHOWS FACEBOOK PAGES)
7. Entry video must begin with the show specific entry card, which can be obtained via Facebook.
8. Judging will take place Friday May 29th. Results will be announced Sunday May 31st.
9. There will be 8 divisions, they will all be shown by weight:
 - a. Market Hogs
 - b. Breeding Gilts (shown by declared weight, cross and purebred compete together)
 - c. Market Lambs
 - d. Breeding Ewes (shown by declared weight, cross and purebred compete together)
 - e. Market Goats
 - f. Breeding Does (shown by declared weight, cross and purebred compete together)
 - g. Market Steers
 - h. Breeding Heifers (shown by weight, cross and purebred compete together)
10. Awards and payouts will be based on entries from each division.
11. Females may cross enter except for cattle.
12. Exhibitors are responsible for the care and grooming of their own animals. We encourage parent assistance keeping in mind this is a Junior show.
13. Both shows are sanctioned by Snake River Show Circuit, 509 show circuit and Oregon Junior Pork Producers.
14. Weight classes may be merged and broken down depending on the number of entries exhibited.
